



A Christmas Carol

8. A hanging piece of ice that forms when melting snow or ice refreezes as water drips down.
6. A figure made of snow, usually with stones or coal for eyes and a carrot for the nose, built during winter.

Down:

1. A vehicle used for sliding over snow, often pulled by a dog or used by children for fun.
3. Tiny, unique ice crystals that fall from the sky during winter.
4. Frozen water, often found in winter or when liquids turn solid.
5. A piece of cloth worn around the neck to keep warm.
7. Gloves with a single compartment for the fingers and a separate one for the thumb, worn to keep hands warm in winter.

Chocolate Marshmallow Cookies

INGREDIENTS:

1 cup (230 g) unsalted butter, room temperature
1 cup light brown sugar
1/2 cup white sugar
2 eggs
2 teaspoons vanilla extract
2 1/4 cups (280 g) all-purpose flour
1 teaspoon baking soda
1/2 teaspoon salt
1 1/2 cups chocolate chips (or chopped dark chocolate)
1 cup mini marshmallows or chopped marshmallows



Instructions:

Preheat oven to 350°F (180°C). Line a baking sheet with parchment paper.

In a large bowl, cream together butter, brown sugar, and white sugar until light and fluffy.

Add the eggs one at a time, beating well after each addition, then blend in the vanilla.

In a separate bowl, whisk together flour, baking soda, and salt.

Gradually add the dry ingredients to the butter mixture, mixing until just combined.

Fold in the chocolate chips and marshmallows.

Drop spoonfuls of dough onto the prepared baking sheet, spacing cookies about 2 inches (5 cm) apart.


Bake for 10–12 minutes, until edges are golden. The center may look slightly soft. Let cool on the sheet for 5 minutes, then transfer to a wire rack to cool completely.

Tips:

To prevent marshmallows from fully melting, add them closer to the end of baking or use finely chopped marshmallows.

Add a pinch of ground cinnamon for depth of flavor.

For a denser cookie, reduce the flour by 2–3 tablespoons.



New Year's Film Journey



Winter


Ice upon the branches .
