2022 - YEAR OF OUTSTANDING COUNTRYMEN OF CHUVASHIA

On September 13, 2021, the head of the region, Oleg Nikolaev, signed a decree declaring 2022 the Year of Outstanding Compatriots of Chuvashia. Our republic is proud of its hardworking, creative, active countrymen.. Wherever we have been, everywhere you can meet the natives of our republic, who glorify the Chuvash region.

Nikita Yakovlevich Bichurin (August 29, 1777–May 11, 1853)

He is an outstanding sinologist and mongolian scholar, traveler, and writer. He received a higher theological education. For 14 years he headed the Russian Orthodox Mission in Beijing. Excellent knowledge of the Chinese language allowed him to professionally study the history of the peoples of Central Asia, South Siberia and the Far East, their languages, writing, economy and culture. In 1828, the Russian Academy of Sciences elected him a corresponding member, and his works were awarded the Demidov Prize four times. Bichurin was a friend of the poets Pushkin and Krylov, the painter Bryullov, the writer Odoevsky.





Ivan Yakovlevich Yakovlev (April 25, 1848 - October 23, 1930)


He is an educator, missionary, teacher, translator, writer, folklorist. He was engaged in the organization of public schools, created the modern Chuvash alphabet, textbooks in the Chuvash and Russian languages for Chuvash students.

Thanks to him, thousands of students began to learn according to the new national alphabet, he put a lot of effort into bringing the Chuvash culture closer to Russian, translated books to make them accessible to his compatriots, raised more than one generation of teachers who became worthy successors of his work.

Nikolay Ivanovich Ashmarin (September 22, 1870 - August 26, 1933)

Throughout his scientific activity, he collected and described various genres of Chuvash oral literature, the religious and ritual foundations of the Chuvash folk culture, analyzed the features of the Chuvash dialects.

He made a great contribution to the development of culture and education of the Chuvash people. World fame was brought to him by the work "Dictionary of the Chuvash language", consisting of 17 volumes, which absorbed a huge wealth of oral and poetic creativity of the Chuvash people, which is a valuable source in the study of the Chuvash language.





Konstantin Vasilievich Ivanov (May 27, 1890–March 26, 1915)

He is the graduate of the Simbirsk Chuvash teacher's school. He worked at the Simbirsk Chuvash teacher's school. Konstantin Vasilievich wrote poems, poetic tales, ballads, tragedies, poems, a series of stories. Thanks to him, the Chuvash people read the works of M. Lermontov, N. Nekrasov, A. Koltsov, N. Ogarev, K. Balmont in their native language. With his participation a new "Primer for the Chuvash using the Russian alphabet" was prepared and published. The poet successfully worked in the field of painting: he painted scenery, illustrations for the primer, was fond of photography.

Nadezhda Vasilievna Pavlova (May 15, 1956)

She was born in Cheboksary. In 1975-1995 Nadezhda Vasilie was a ballet soloist at the Bolshoi Theater, where she performed more than 20 roles in performances of the classical repertoire and contemporary choreographers. She performed in Austria, Yugoslavia, Italy, etc. After the end of her ballet career, she continued to work as a teacher-repetiteur, participated in creative evenings of classical ballet masters. She starred in the Soviet-American feature film The Blue Bird (directed by J. Cukor). Her main roles are Svanilda, Juliet, Kitri, Giselle, Masha, Aurora (The Sleeping Beauty by P.I. Tchaikovsky), Phrygia (Spartacus by A.I. Khachaturian), Eola (Icarus by S.M. Slonimsky), Katerina (Stone Flower by S.S. Prokofiev) and others.





Sespel Mikhail (Kuzmin Mikhail Kuzmich) (November 16, 1899–June 15, 1922)

He is a classic of Chuvash literature, reformer of versification, artist, poet, playwright, prose writer, and translator.

M. Sespel is one of the public and state figures of Chuvashia in the first years of the formation of its autonomy.

He is the founder of syllabo-tonic versification in Chuvash poetry. Sespel expanded the lyrical possibilities of the verse, based on the experience of Russian classical poetry, the best examples of prerevolutionary Chuvash literature and folklore. The first collection of poems was published in 1928. Since then, his works have been published in different languages of the peoples of the world.



Nikolay Vasilievich Nikolsky (May 19, 1878 - November 2, 1961)

He is the graduate of the Kazan Theological Academy. In 1906 he organized the publication of the first Chuvash newspaper "Khypar". He worked at Kazan University, Eastern Conservatory, Eastern Pedagogical Institute. In 1940-1950 he was a senior researcher of the Mari Research Institute and a professor of the Mari Pedagogical Institute.

He is the author of about 200 scientific papers. According to the programs he created, a huge amount of material on the history, ethnography and folklore of the Chuvash people was collected by him.

Fedor Pavlovich Pavlov September 25, 1892 - June 02, 1931

He is a poet, composer, playwright, conductor, folklorist, cultural and educational figure, organizer of musical education and the Chuvash national choir in the republic.

He began his literary activity by composing poems, united in the cycle "A Monument to My Youth". In 1919 he published the first original Chuvash comedy "Sutra" (On the court), and in 1922 the drama "Yalta" (In the village).

A major contribution to the development of national art was the creation of works for orchestras: symphonic ("Sarnaipa palnai" (Sarnai and palnai)) and wind (march "Forward, Red Chuvashia").




READING IS A BRIDGE OF KNOWLEDGE




That's right! We asked several questions about reading to our students in grades 5 and 6. The result of the survey is presented in the form of diagrams.



1. Simple ice cream from cream and condensed milk

Ingredients

- 200 g cream for whipping;
- 100 g of condensed milk.

Cooking

Whip the cold cream with a mixer until creamy. Then mix them with condensed milk. Put the mass in a wide form, cover with a lid and put in the freezer for 3-5 hours.

2. Banana ice cream


Ingredients

- 3 bananas;
- 60 ml of milk;
- a pinch of vanilla.

Cooking

Cut bananas into slices and put in the freezer for several hours. Blend frozen bananas, milk and vanilla in a blender until smooth. Put the mass in a wide form, cover with a lid and put it in the freezer for 1-2 hours.

Ingredients

- 480 ml cream;
- 380 g of condensed milk;
- 150–200 g strawberries.

Cooking

Whip the cold cream with a mixer until creamy. Add condensed milk and beat again until smooth. Cut strawberries into small pieces, put in a creamy mass and mix. Put the ice cream in a wide mold, cover with a film or a lid and put it in the freezer for 3-4 hours.

- Ice cream appeared in antiquity. It has been known to humanity for at least five thousand years.
- The first to discover ice cream were the Chinese, who liked to serve frozen fruit juices at the festive table, which eventually turned into what we call "fruit ice".
- Even Alexander the Great liked to restore his strength with a cold dessert, and Hippocrates even used this delicacy as a cure for the heat.
