The Secret Garden


Frances Hodgson Burnett


The Night Circus

Cinnamon Rolls

For the dough:

- 4 cups all-purpose flour
- 1/3 cup granulated sugar
- 2 1/4 teaspoons active dry yeast (1 packet)
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1 cup warm milk (about 110°F/45°C)
- 1/3 cup unsalted butter, melted
- 2 large eggs

For the filling:

- 1/2 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 1 cup brown sugar
- 2 tablespoons ground cinnamon



For the cream cheese frosting:

- 4 oz cream cheese, softened
- 1/4 cup unsalted butter, softened
- 1 to 1 1/2 cups powdered sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1-2 tablespoons milk (optional, for consistency)

Instructions:

1.Prepare the dough:

- In a small bowl, dissolve the yeast in warm milk. Let it sit for 5-10 minutes until frothy.
- In a large mixing bowl, combine flour, sugar, and salt.
- Add the melted butter, eggs, and the yeast mixture to the dry ingredients.
- Mix until a dough forms, then knead on a floured surface for about 5-7 minutes until smooth and elastic.
- Place the dough in a greased bowl, cover with a damp cloth, and let it rise in a warm place for 1-2
 hours, or until doubled in size.

2.Prepare the filling:

In a small bowl, mix the softened butter, brown sugar, and cinnamon until well combined.

3.Assemble the rolls:

- Punch down the risen dough and roll it out on a floured surface into a rectangle about 16x12 inches.
- Spread the cinnamon filling evenly over the dough.
- Roll up the dough tightly from the longer side to form a log.
- Cut the log into 12-15 equal slices.

4.Bake:

- Place the slices in a greased baking dish, leaving some space between them.
- Cover and let rise for another 30 minutes.
- Preheat the oven to 350°F (175°C).
- Bake the rolls for 20-25 minutes, until golden brown.


5. Prepare the cream:

- Mix powdered sugar, milk, and vanilla to make the glaze.
- Drizzle over warm rolls before serving.

What is autumn for me?


